



## COALITION OF LA CITY UNIONS BARGAINING UPDATE

**Tell Los Angeles City Leaders:**

***“Stop the Delay.  
We Need a Contract to Fix L.A!”***

Coalition of LA City Unions negotiators and our community partners in the Fix LA coalition **have returned to the bargaining table twice in the New Year** — on January 14 and January 7 — to try and move contract talks forward.

**City management continues to stall, however, refusing to budge from its aggressive concessionary agenda**, including proposing these attacks (per average City worker):

- **Making you pay an additional \$1,920/year for health insurance!**
- **Tripling the time it takes for you to reach the top of the pay scale!**
- **Slashing by 30 percent your career earning potential!**
- **Massive deterioration in Workers' Comp benefits**

Our community allies have consistently spoken about blighted streets and alleyways, underfunded parks and recreational programs, library closures and other problems caused by City staffing shortages, unenlightened austerity policies, and assaults on the middle class.

But is the City listening?

NOPE.

City Hall hasn't given us even the basic respect of *considering* our community-based policy proposals to Fix LA — which we made more than three months ago to increase resources.
